Research Analysis

HB2716 requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to post information annually by Jan. 1 on payments made to providers for home- and community-based services for individuals with intellectual disabilities and a strategic plan for serving more individuals with intellectual disabilities. By the fifth day of each month, DHS must post online the number of individuals with intellectual disabilities currently receiving home- or community-based services, services provided including waivers received, demographic information on individuals on the waiting list, number of applicants who started receiving services during the assessment period, any relevant trends in data, the frequency of contact and mode of contact between applicants and DHS, resource gaps, resources or community supports that need expansion, the number of individuals who stopped receiving services in the prior month, and total expenditures for services by month and year to date.
