Research Analysis

The CS to HB 2730 provides that if a records request cannot be completed within ten business days of the request, a person from the public body receiving the record request must provide written notice to the requestor indicating the reason for the delay and specifying a date within a reasonable time when the information requested will be available for inspection or duplication.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2730 requires any public body who is unable to complete a records request within ten (10) business days of the request to provide a written notice to the requestor of the records indicating the reason for the delay and an estimated date the information will be available. As statute already requires the prompt, reasonable access to public records with delays being limited solely to the time required for preparing the requested documents, this measure has no direct or revenue considerations for the state.
