**Research Analysis**

HB 2789 clarifies who is authorized to seek relief under the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act by including any adult victim of a crime with a need to prevent further victimization. The measure allows for the collection of service fee by the sheriff for serving a stalking warning letter.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure clarifies who is authorized to seek relief under the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act and allows for the Court Clerks to collect a sheriff's fee for serving or endeavoring to serve a stalking warning letter. The Oklahoma Court Information System does not maintain data when a stalking warning letter is issued so the amount of collections pursuant to HB2789 is not predictable, however there is no anticipated impact on state budget or appropriations.
