Research Analysis

The amendment for HB 2790 deletes Section 5 in its entirety.

HB 2790, as amended, establishes The Oklahoma Hospital Cybersecurity Protection Act of 2023. The measure is voluntary, and allows for covered entities to seek an affirmative defense under the measure should an allegation arise that the failure to implement reasonable information security controls resulted in a data breach concerning personal information or restricted information. The measure also outlines the mandatory conditions which allow a covered entity to seek an affirmative defense under the measure. The measure adds a protection that If any provision of the measure or its application to a covered entity is for any reason held invalid, the remainder of the provisions under those sections and the application of such provisions to other covered entities will not be affected.
