Research Analysis

The second proposed committee substitute for HB 2830 adds memory care to the types of care treatments that special care facilities must disclose to the Department of Health when advertising their methods as especially suitable to dementia patients. The measure also provides that individuals employed by facilities that advertise that they provide such care may be liable for civil penalties and charged with a misdemeanor as determined by the Commissioner of Health if the facility does not meet the criteria of a memory care, Alzheimer's care, or dementia care facility.
