Research Analysis

HB 2855, as introduced, allows a holder of a Retail Beer or Retail Wine License who was licensed and permitted to sell low-point beer for off-premises consumption until the passage of State Question 792 to hold an ownership interest in a manufacturer who make products out of state. This provision applies only to the interests that the retailer held as of November 8, 2016 and the retailer owned by the manufacturer does not offer for sale at its Oklahoma retail location any wine or spirits that are made by the commonly owned manufacturer.

Fiscal Analysis

In its current form, HB2855 allows certain holders of a Retail Beer or Retail Wine License to hold an ownership interest in a manufacturer that creates products outside of the state. This measure is not expected to constitute a material impact to state revenues or state appropriations.
