Research Analysis

HB 2899 provides that the Legislature finds that Oklahoma has benefitted from the intergovernmental agreements and compact with Tribal nations on a variety of subjects, including agreements relating to motor vehicle licensing and registration matters which have benefitted all parties by reducing disputes and increasing revenues available for roads, bridges, schools, and other community infrastructure. The measure adds a supplemental term to any Tribe that was, as of January 1, 2023, a party to a motor vehicle licensing or registration agreement. The measure allows such Tribe to accept this offer and be granted an additional five year extension of the compact term.
