- \$4,550,000 million to the Victims of Human Trafficking and Prevention Revolving Fund;
- \$7,896,567 to the Federal Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure transfers funds previously appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) as follows:

- \$4,550,000 to the Victims of Human Trafficking and Prevention Revolving Fund
- \$7,896,567 to the Federal Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Fund

In its current form, HB2925 allows for the transfer of existing funds within an agency and has a budget neutral impact to state budget and appropriations.
