Research Analysis

The floor substitute to HB 2965 allows horse races that are held at racetracks licensed by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission to be televised out-of-state, out-of-country, or to other racetracks licensed by the Commission.

CHANGES IN FLOOR SUB VERSION FROM INTRODUCED:

Adds clarification that the provisions of [Title 34 Sections 205.6](#) and [205.6a](#) do not apply to any agreements subject to the Interstate Horse Racing Act of 1978 pertaining to the export signal of live races across state lines.
