## **Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 2966 creates the crime of assault and battery upon a municipal building inspector or municipal code enforcement officer while in the performance of their duties. The penalty is a misdemeanor punishable by up to 1 year in the county jail, a fine of up to \$1,000 or both fine and imprisonment. A second or subsequent conviction is a felony punishable by up to 2 years in prison, a fine of up to \$2,000 or both fine and imprisonment. Aggravated assault and battery upon a municipal building inspector or municipal code enforcement officer while in the performance of their duties is a felony, punishable by not less than 2 years nor more than 5 years in prison, a fine of up to \$5,000 or both fine and imprisonment.
