Research Analysis

HB 3009 requires the online driver license renewal system used by Service Oklahoma include a step requiring the selection of a licensed operator to complete the processing of their driver license renewal.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3009 would allow anyone renewing their driver license online to be allowed to select any licensed operator in the state to complete the processing of their renewal, as well as implementing a notification system to those licensed operators. Service Oklahoma generated a net revenue from online renewals of One Million, Five Hundred Thirty-five Thousand, Twenty-six dollars and Seventy-five cents (\$1,535,026.75) for FY-23. This measure would result in a reduction of the following amounts to Service Oklahoma's annual budget:

FY-25: \$1,023,351.16 decrease in fee revenue to Service Oklahoma

FY-26: \$1,535,026.75 decrease in fee revenue to Service Oklahoma

Additionally, Service Oklahoma estimates a recurring administrative cost of Eighty Thousand dollars (\$80,000.00) to redevelop its online renewable platform to incorporate this change.
