The proposed committee substitute to HB 3023 establishes that any public official, employer, or employee that retaliates against a whistleblower is guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to incarceration of up to one year and a fine of \$5,000 and is liable for all economic, emotional, and mental aguish. The offending public official, employer, or employee is prohibited from holding a public office or employment.
