**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3033 appropriates up to Four Million Two hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,200,00.00) from the Statewide Recovery Fund to the State Department of Health (OSDH) to build out a long-term stay mental health ward in southeast Oklahoma for adolescences. This measure requires the funds to be deposited into a Statewide Recovery Special Account, which must continue in accordance to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

HB 3033 allows OSDH to retain no more than two percent (2%) of the appropriated funds for administrative costs, therefore, officials from OSDH do not anticipate a negative fiscal impact due to the passing of this measure.
