Research Analysis

The committee amendment to HB3039 increases the population qualifier for counties that are required to transfer a portion of its court funds to the law library fund each year from 300,000 to 500,000.

As amended, the measure modifies procedures related to the transfer of funds to the law library and increases, from \$6 to \$12, the law library fund fee for all civil court filings in any county that has a population greater than 500,000 people. The current fee is law library fee is \$6 regardless of the county population. Counties with a population less than 500,000 are required to send a portion of its court funds, up to \$9,000 per year depending on the population of the county, to the law library fund.
