**Research Analysis**

The subcommittee recommendation for HB3039 modifies procedures related to the transfer of funds to the law library and increases, from \$6 to \$12, the law library fund fee for all civil court filings in any county that has a population greater than 500,000 people. The current fee is law library fee is \$6 regardless of the county population. Counties with a population less than 500,000 are required to send a portion of its court funds, up to \$9,000 per year depending on the population of the county, to the law library fund.
