Research Analysis

The CS to HB 3056 allows the storage of a firearm properly displayed or stored in a privately owned vehicle on school property. The measure provides that any person who is not precluded from lawfully owning and possessing a firearm pursuant to state law shall be considered to be individually authorized by the State of Oklahoma within the meaning of the provisions regarding individual licensure and verification pursuant to the federal Gun-Free School Zones Act of 1990. The measure allows a firearms safety and training course instructor to qualify an applicant on an air-powered pistol.
