**Research Analysis**

HB3057, as introduced, eliminates the central purchasing act exemption for IT purchases by the Information Services Division (ISD) of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services and the Chief Information Officer (CIO). The approval and purchase of all equipment, products and services by the CIO and ISD will now be subject to the competitive bidding and central purchasing requirements.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3057 requires all purchases by the Information Services Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) and the Chief Information Officer to be subject to the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act for the purchase of all equipment, products, and services. Per OMES, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
