**Research Analysis**

House Bill 3061, as introduced, provides that any declaration of emergency made by the Governor terminates either upon the Governor's proclamation or automatically after 30 days unless renewed by the Legislature.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3061 establishes that any emergency proclaimed by the Governor shall end automatically after thirty (30) days unless renewed by concurrent resolution of the Legislature and any emergency proclaimed by the Legislature to end upon passage of a concurrent resolution by the Legislature to terminate the emergency. This measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
