**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3071 prohibits the use of any state revenues to be knowingly used to provide benefits to an unauthorized person present in the state. As written, this measure would apply to all state agencies, and thus all state agencies would have to enact policies to ensure compliance with this measure. As the policies would vary between state agencies, a true fiscal impact of this measure cannot be determined at this time.
