Research Analysis

HB 3074, as introduced, directs the State Board of Education to review the average teacher compensation in neighboring states every odd-numbered year. If the average teacher compensation in surrounding states is higher than in Oklahoma based on the Minimum Salary Schedule, the legislature must introduce a bill for a pay increase. The bill will proceed directly to the floor in each chamber and must be scheduled for debate within five legislative days. After the debate, a roll call vote is required within three legislative days. If passed, the bill becomes law upon enactment.
