Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3074 directs the State Board of Education to review the average teacher salary in neighboring states every odd-numbered year. If the average teacher salary in surrounding states is higher than in Oklahoma, the legislature must introduce a bill for a teacher pay increase. The bill will pass committee, proceed directly to the floor in each chamber, and be scheduled for debate within five legislative days. After the debate, a roll call vote is required within three legislative days. If passed, the bill becomes law upon enactment.
