Research Analysis

House Bill 3101, as introduced, amends the Oklahoma Sunset Law that re-creates a Long-Term Care Facility Advisory Council to advise the State Commissioner of Health. The Advisory Council will be composed of 14 members appointed by the Governor and serve until July 1, 2025. Members will be appointed for two-year terms and can be re-appointed for up to two terms. The Council will have the power and duty to serve as an advisory body to the Department for the development and improvement of services to and care and treatment of residents of facilities subject to the provisions of the Nursing Home Care Act, homes subject to the provisions of the Residential Care Act and facilities subject to the provisions of the Adult Day Care Act.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3101 increases the membership of the Long-Term Care Facility Advisory Board from thirteen (13) to fourteen (14) members, requiring the member to be an operator-administrator of an intermediate care facility. The addition to the Board is not anticipated to create a fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriation.
