Fiscal Analysis

This measure adds international or domestic drug trafficking activity to the definition of terrorism in OS 21-1268.1. The crime of terrorism is punishable by imprisonment within the custody of the Department of Corrections and/or the imposition of fines and fees to be collected by Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC). The frequency of new convictions from expanding the scope of this crime is not predictable, however the \$16.60/day marginal cost of incarceration would apply and be absorbed by existing budgetary resources within the DOC. In its current form, HB3133 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
