Fiscal Analysis

This measure creates new crime related to terrorism. Per O.S. 21 – 1268.2, every act of terrorism is a felony which has the potential to create new imprisonments within the Department of Corrections (DOC) at a marginal cost of \$16.60/day per inmate to be absorbed by existing budgetary resources, and generate new revenues for the Administrative of the Courts (AOC) in the form of fines and fees collected. The frequency of new crime cannot be predicted. In its current form, HB3133 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
