**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3167 creates the Accessibility of Government Services Task Force. The task force is to have 11 members, who are to be appointed by September 1, 2024. The purpose of the task force is to study, evaluate, and make recommendations regarding strategies to improve the accessibility and customer service of state agencies and the additional services to be offered by Service Oklahoma. The task force is required to submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and legislative leadership by December 1, 2024.

**Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, HB3167 creates the Accessibility of Government Services Task Force. The task force would exist to evaluate and improve the accessibility and customer service of state agencies and the additional services offered by Service Oklahoma. The eleven members of the task force are to be appointed by September 1, 2024, and the task force is required to submit a report of its findings to the Governor and legislative leadership by December 1, 2024.

This measure is not expected to impact state revenue or state appropriations.

The committee substitute does not change the fiscal impact of the bill.
