**Research Analysis**

The SAHB changes responsibility to promulgate rules regarding the use of grills on docks from the Oklahoma Department of Tourism to the Oklahoma State Fire Marshall.

HB 3169 directs the Oklahoma Department of Tourism to promulgate rules allowing the use and storage of propane-fueled grills and flattop griddles and electric wood pellet grills on boat docks. Violations are to be assessed to the person committing acts in violation of the rules. The owner or operator of marina or dock is not to be held liable for the actions of its tenants and others.
