Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3196 removes the maximum number of Oklahoma State University (OSU) veterinary students that can be accepted into the rural Oklahoma veterinary training program. Funding preference will be given to students currently enrolled in the OSU College of Veterinary Medicine focused on large animals. The measure also increases the maximum amount of funds each student can receive per year from \$20,000 to \$25,000.

This measure moves the administration of the student loan repayment program from the Veterinary School to the Oklahoma State University Veterinary Medical Authority (OSUVMA) and makes some minor changes to the program.
