Fiscal Analysis

HB 3212 provides for the dissolution of a board by the Office of the Governor for failing to meet sixty percent (60%) of the time due to lack of quorum. If a board were to be dissolved, the authority of the board would be vested in the Cabinet Secretary and the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to carry out the mission and purpose of the board. Per OMES, the impact of this measure would be dependent on the board that is dissolved. As written, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations at this time.
