Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to House Bill 3238 removes language requiring the State Department of Health to establish a licensing process for Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) organizations, and exempts PACE organizations from licensure by the State Department of Health.

AS AMENDED

House Bill 3238 establishes the Oklahoma Health Care Authority as the state administering agency responsible for administering Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) program agreements. The measure specifies the powers and duties of the involved entities and authorizes the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board to promulgate rules. Additionally, the legislation excludes PACE organizations from the definitions of adult daycare centers and home care agencies.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure exempts PACE organizations from licensure by the State Department of Health pursuant to certain Acts. The Senate Amendment to House Bill 3238 does not alter the fiscal impact of the measure. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
