Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3278 alters certain high school graduation requirements. Students in grades 8th through 12th must complete a total of four math units, with Algebra I and Geometry as the two mandatory courses. Students must also complete six Individualized Career and Academic Plan (ICAP) pathway units that may cover a variety of subjects and career paths upon selection by the district board of education. The measure also includes a postsecondary-approved full-time CareerTech program or locally approved science-based application course as satisfaction for the required physical science unit. Additionally, CareerTech programs are no longer required to be approved by the state and district boards of education for high school credit.
