**Research Analysis**

HB3284, as introduced, modifies the membership and duties of the Governmental Technology Applications Review Board. The Governor will have one less appointee to the board to allow the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court to be able to appoint one member to the board. The board will also be tasked with ongoing oversight and approval of all rates set or changed by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
