HB 3297, as introduced, allows a student who has completed the core curriculum graduation requirements to be eligible for an Oklahoma's Promise scholarship to a CareerTech school.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure in its current form would expand OHLAP eligibility in the CareerTech system. According to figures provided by the Department of Career and Technology Education, there are approximately 200 students who fit the criteria outlined in the measure as written. Currently, the average tuition for the CareerTech system is \$2,310. As such, the anticipated fiscal impact would be approximately \$462,000 for the current fiscal year.

OHLAP, or Oklahoma's Promise, is funded through "off the top" means. Therefore, this would not result in a direct fiscal impact to appropriation, however it would reduce the overall amount that would be available for appropriation each fiscal year.
