**Research Analysis**

The proposed subcommittee substitute for HB 3329 requires public and charter schools with 6th through 12th grades to provide free menstrual products in all female, single-use, and standalone handicapped bathrooms as well as a neutral location such as a nurse's office or administrative office. Schools with grades below 6th are required to provide menstrual products solely in a neutral location.
