**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB3361 modifies pre-packaging requirements for all medical marijuana flower, trim, shake, kief, and other flower-based products not classified as concentrates and sold by licensed processors and growers to licensed dispensaries. Products must be sold in packages ranging in size from one-half (1/2) gram to three (3) ounces. Nonopaque packaging materials are permissible, provided all other packaging and labeling regulations are adhered to and the product is placed in an opaque container before leaving the dispensary. Displaying and smelling medical marijuana are permitted.

Additionally, the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority is directed to establish rules for returning defective or hazardous pre-packaged products to dispensaries and for returning products between licensed entities.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3361 directs the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) to promulgate rules for the return of defective or hazardous pre-packaged products. OMMA intends to utilize existing staff to establish such rules. As written, this measure is not anticipated to create a negative impact on the agency or state budget.
