**Research Analysis**

HB 3544, as introduced, qualifies a person with any level of degree or two years of experience in child care or education as a master teacher. Additionally, a person replacing a master teacher at a child care center is authorized as a master teacher during the probationary period while pursuing educational qualifications.
