Fiscal Analysis

HB 3566 modifies acts that shall cause certain persons to be held accountable as a youthful offender. Specifically, this measure adds that a person is held accountable as a youthful offender when eluding a police officer in violation of certain Oklahoma Statutes. After communication with the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA), this measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
