**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 3570 allows for the use of automatic license plate readers for certain purposes and requires the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) to issue a permit to the municipal or state law enforcement agency that intends to use the reader on a state or interstate highway. Per ODOT, the implementation and administration of this measure would have a minimal fiscal impact for the agency.
