Research Analysis

HB 3593 removes a requirement that a reinstated officer to the Department of Public Safety will be able to complete twenty years of credited service by the time the reinstated officer reaches 62 years of age.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure removes a requirement that officers reinstated to the Department of Public Safety be able to complete 20 years of service by the time the officer would reach 62 years of age. Officials from the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System (OLERS) have provided that, according to actuarial analysis, HB3593 is anticipated to have little to no impact on OLERS. Therefore, there is no material impact to state budget or appropriations as a result of this measure. There is an OPLAA statement on the introduced version of this measure, and the actuary states this is a non-fiscal bill.
