Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3717 directs Service Oklahoma to coordinate with the Secretary of the State Election Board to create a voter ID card that will include a photograph of the voter. This card will be issued at no cost and be used solely for voting purposes. Beginning January 1, 2026, only voter ID cards with a photograph or a state, federal or tribal issued photo ID may be used as proof of identify for voting purposes. The paper voter ID cards with no photograph that are currently issued by county election boards will not be accepted after January 1, 2026.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3717 requires Service Oklahoma to develop a voter identification card provided free of charge to be used by voters beginning January 1, 2026. It is currently unknown the number of individuals who are registered to vote but who do not currently have a driver license or state identification card, therefore the overall impact of this measure is unknown at this time. Service Oklahoma does note that the current printing cost per credential is One dollar and Fifty cents (\$1.50).
