FA1 to HB 3752 requires the Department of Corrections designee the Domestic Violence Fatality Review Board to have a minimum of five years of experience in corrections and who is currently assigned to the Community Outreach, Programs, or Population Units of the Department.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure authorizes the Domestic Violence Fatality Review Board to obtain certain records from the Department of Corrections (DOC), and increases the membership of the Board to include the Director of the DOC. Any additional costs are expected to be absorbed through existing agency resources. In its current form, HB3752 is not anticipated to have an impact on state budget or appropriations.

The FA1 designates certain qualification requirements for membership on the Board and does not create fiscal impact to the measure.
