Research Analysis

HB 3819, as introduced, authorizes the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission to establish a continuing education program for construction industry workers affected by the codes adopted by the commission, code officials, design professionals, and building trades workers. Participants other than state-licensed code officials may be charged a fee.

The measure also requires the commission to establish a workforce development process to increase the number of available code officials. The process will involve individuals completing regional training and receiving certification for inspections.

Additionally, the measure directs the commission to establish rules requiring proposed energy building codes or amendments to include a payback period of seven years or less or a statement explaining why a payback period is not applicable.
