Research Analysis

HB 3828 requires OMES and the Administrative Office of the Courts to inventory all systems that use artificial intelligence (AI) by December 31, 2024 and each year after. State agencies that do not use OMES must inventory their own systems and post the inventory list on their website. By February 1, 2025 OMES, the Administrative Office of the Courts, and any state agencies that do not use OMES are required to perform assessments of their AI systems to ensure the systems do not discriminate and to establish policies and procedures regarding the use of AI and post them on their website.

Additionally, beginning February 1, 2025 state agencies are prohibited from implementing AI systems unless an impact assessment has been performed to ensure that using such system will not result in discrimination. State agencies are also prohibited from implementing AI systems if the agency director determines the use of the AI system will result in discrimination.
