Research Analysis

HB 3932 allows a person who surrenders their license to Service Oklahoma due to a suspension or revocation to make application for and receive a Noncompliant Identification Card at no charge.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3932 allows a person who surrenders their driver license due to suspension or revocation to make application to receive a Noncompliant Identification Card at no charge. Per Service Oklahoma, Eight Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty-two (8,362) individuals had their driver license suspended in FY-23. The current cost of a REAL ID Noncompliant Identification Card is Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for an eight-year credential. If all individuals who had their driver license suspended were to receive an eight-year credential, the estimated decrease in driver license revenue to Service Oklahoma in a full fiscal year would be Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand One Hundred dollars (\$418,100.00).

As this measure has an effective date of November 1, 2024, the estimated fiscal impact for FY-25 would be Two Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty-three dollars and Thirty-four cents (\$278,733.34), with a full fiscal year impact expected for FY-26. Service Oklahoma also estimates the administrative costs for implementation of this measure to be Thirty-two Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty-four dollars (\$32,384.00).
