**Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute to HB 3972 authorizes the Attorney General to accept assignments from any person and represent those claims in legal matters or proceedings within the jurisdiction of the State of Oklahoma if the Governor has declared a state of emergency. The measure provides that the Attorney General should only accept assignments if they are in the best interest of the public.
