Research Analysis

HB 4090 criminalizes the unlawful presence in the United States by providing that a person who is arrested and is found to be unlawfully present is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not less than 10 years. In lieu of the prison sentence, the court may issue a written order requiring the person to return to the foreign nation from which the person entered if the person agrees to the order and has not previously been convicted of a violent crime and the person is not charged with another felony offense.
