## **Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 4095 amends the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act by:

- Defining watch and protect, pre-excavation meeting request, and large projects;
- Amending the definition of *underground facility* to include projects in a private easement;
- Prohibiting excavation projects designated as "watch and protect" from taking place without the operator or designated representative present;
- Requiring that "watch and protect" projects submit contact information to the Oklahoma One-Call System;
- Creating a notification process for large projects; and
- Requiring the Oklahoma One-Call System to keep notifications and positive responses for at least four years.
