**Research Analysis**

HB 4118, as introduced, modifies the best management practices for poultry waste that are outlined in the Oklahoma Registered Poultry Feeding Operations Act by removing prohibitions against runoff or discharge of poultry waste into waters of the state. In addition, the measure grants prospective and retroactive legal immunity to poultry integrators, employees, contractors whose land application practices are in compliance with a state-approved nutrient management plan.
