The subcommittee amendment to HB 4132 modifies the additional training as optional instead of mandatory.

HB 4132, as amended, allows officers participating in the School Resource Officer Program to additionally complete 40 hours of Basic School Resource Officer Course training and 12 hours of Adolescent Mental Health Training.
