Research Analysis

House Bill 4152, as introduced, requires all healthcare facilities performing mammography exams to include in the mammography report summary, information identifying the patient's individual breast density classification as dense or not dense. If the facility determines that a patient has heterogeneously or extremely dense breast tissue, the summary must also include a notice informing the patient about the implications of breast density on cancer detection and risk, advising them to discuss these matters with their healthcare provider. The measure stipulates the exact wording of the notice.
