**Research Analysis**

HB 4157, as introduced, requires the State Board of Equalization to show the amount of revenue needed to fund the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program as available for appropriation from the General Revenue Fund. The total transfers to the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Trust Fund must be less than the transfer amount authorized by budget legislation for a fiscal year.
